Camping Regulations Agreement**

I/We \_\_\_\_\_ agree to abide by the following rules and policies for using the Powder Horn Mountain campground. Complete rules are posted at the campground.

1. **Fires:** Fires are permitted only in the fire rings and barbeque pits at the picnic grounds. Extinguish all fires before leaving the picnic area. **Do not leave any fire unattended.**
2. **Wood Gathering:** Wood gathering for use as fire wood is limited to dead material lying on the ground within the picnic area. Stacks of firewood may be available at various sites around the campground.
3. **Disturbance of Animal or Plant Life:** Wildlife must not be disturbed in any way. Hunting and trapping animals are prohibited. Please store food in locked vehicle to avoid attracting wildlife. Please do not drive nails into trees or strip bark, leaves, or branches from trees or shrubs.
4. **Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash no longer than six feet or under physical restraint at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
5. **Cleaning Campsite:** Campers are responsible for cleaning campsite before leaving. Remove camping equipment and dispose of all trash in trash cans at picnic area.
6. **Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please keep in mind that loud music at any time of day or night disturbs property owners on the mountain and other campers using the campground.
7. **Parking:** For overnight camping, a maximum of two vehicles will be allowed to park at each reserved site. Additional parking is available at the campground overflow parking area. Your vehicle(s) must be parked at the campsite you are using. Under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked at someone else's campsite.

**Properly Extinguishing Your Campfire**

In addition to not leaving your fire unattended (for any reason and even for a short period of time), it is equally important to properly extinguish your campfire.

When extinguishing your fire, always leave all fire material in the fire pit. Douse with water until all burning material is extinguished.
